RECOMMENDATION

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF NORTH BAY VILLAGE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

Village Staff is seeking a budget amendment to address the following:

Organizational Changes

Commission Aide

 In February 2021, the Village Commission approved the reclassification of the Legislative Aide position into a Commission Aide position, increasing the salary and job responsibilities for the next incumbent. This position was filled in May 2021, with an annual salary of \$50,000. The former Legislative Aide position was budgeted at \$39,784. In order to continue to fund the reclassified position through the end of the current fiscal year, we are requesting a budget amendment in the amount of \$4,345 from Office Supplies and Salary Savings.

Reclassification of Communications and Special Events Coordinator to Director of Communications and Special Events

• In January 2021, our former Communications and Special Events Coordinator separated from employment with the Village. Through a rigorous recruitment process, we faced

significant challenges and were unable to recruit a suitable replacement at an annual salary of \$70,000. Therefore, in January 2021, the position was reclassified to the Director of Communications and Special Events with an annual salary of \$80,000. In order to continue to fund the reclassified position through the end of the current fiscal year, Village Staff is requesting a budget amendment in the amount of \$10,531 from Special Department Supplies and Salary Savings. Backup documentation is attached for reference.

Police Department

• The staffing situation in Communications has become extremely dire, as we are unable to fully complete our communications mission. This situation has become even more critical with the loss of staffing due to various medical reasons. To that end, we a requesting a budget amendment to cover the addition of one (1) dispatcher position through the end of the fiscal year, with the understanding that this position will need to be budgeted for the next fiscal year. The total cost impact of this budget amendment request applicable to FY20/21 is \$14,888. Backup documentation is attached for reference.

Attorney Fees

• We are requesting a budget amendment for attorney fees relating to labor and employment. Estimates are based based on \$250/hour for 30 hours of work). This is to provide services relating to the FOP and FOPA labor negotiations, which will be occurring over the next few months. In addition, the Village currently has three pending arbitrations during his FY's budget, but we are monitoring that matter and may have to adjust the budget accordingly. The other legal fees are being increased based on average cost per month. The total amount being requested in \$71,462 from Unreserved Fund Balance. Please refer to the backup documentation attached for more details.

Island Walk North Plaza - Budget Transfer

Execution of the Island Walk North Plaza Design Revision work proposal requires a budget amendment to transfer \$69,600 from the Park Improvement Fund to Island Walk Design & Permitting Development Account. The cost will be reimbursed \$34,800 from a Florida Inland Navigation District Grants (\$100,000) awarded to the Village for design and permitting of the Island Walk projects.

Vogel Park Marine Facility - Budget Transfer

At the February 9, 2021 commission meeting, Commissioners approved a Work Authorization with EAC Consulting in the amount of \$30,952.33 for Vogel Park Marine Facility surveying, permitting strategy & conceptual design services. Approval require a budget amendment to transfer \$30,952.33 from the Park Improvement Fund to Kayak Launch Park Improvement Account. The portions of cost for the work proposal will be reimbursed in the amount of \$23,000 from a Florida Recreation Development and Acquisition Program grant \$7,500 and Florida Inland Navigation District grant \$15,500.

79th Street Causeway Complete Street Study-Capital Project Fund

Budget Amendment for NBV SR934/79th Street Causeway Corridor Study. We are funding this item with \$60,000 TPO and a matching amount of \$33,675.55 from CITT Fund. The work proposal was approved with Resolution 2021-014, this amendment is to specify budget appropriation.

Island Walk Cost Benefit Analysis-Capital Projects Fund

Transfer \$14,352 from the Park Improvement Fund, allocating reserves from Impact fees to the GL Line item 320.60.630.3116 Capital Projects Fund for professional services for an Island Walk Cost Benefit Analysis.

Pride Event and 4th of July

Allocate donations received for 4th of July event and transfer \$4,600 from Commissioner Chervony's Travel, Conferences & Meetings Line item to cover \$1,000 for 4th of July Event and \$3,600 for Pride Event. In addition we are transferring \$4,000 from Ties School Support to replenish Music at the Park line item, that had previously a budget, but was amended for Vogel Park Sports Event. Total amendment \$11,600. Documentation is attached.

BUDGETARY/FINANCIAL IMPACT (Finance Dept.)

\$ 263,795.88 from various accounts, with \$23,000 Grant Reimbursable for Vogel Park, \$60,000 from TPO Grant for 79th Street Complete Streets Study and \$34,800 Grant Reimbursable for Island Walk.
