RECOMMENDATION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF NORTH BAY VILLAGE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ISSUE A WORK ORDER TO STANTEC CONSULTING SERVICES, INC. FOR DESIGN, PERMITTING, BIDDING ASSISTANCE SERVICES FOR THE KENNEDY CAUSEWAY MEDIAN BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$26,453; AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

A key priority within the NBV100 Master Plan is to landscape the medians on the Kennedy Causeway within the Village boundary limits. Staff submitted an application for an FDOT Beautification Grant in October 2021, which was the top-ranked project in the State this year and was awarded the maximum possible amount of \$100,000. The Letter of Award and the Letter of Acceptance of the award are also attached.

The Village requested Stantec Engineering, under our continuous consultant services contract, to submit a proposal for design engineering, permitting, and bidding services for the Causeway Beautification improvements along the existing medians within Kennedy Causeway, within Village limits.

Landscape design will be provided by landscape architects Curtis and Rogers Design Studio Inc., and assist in the services provided under this agreement. the scope of service is estimated to cost \$26,453. Approval of the Budget Amendment transferring \$26,453 from Repairs & Maintenance of Grounds to fund Capital Project SFM22-05 Kennedy Causeway Median Beautification (Land Improvements) is requested (Please see attached).

The project is expected to beautify the causeway and thereby enhance livability in the village as well as the traveler experience along the roadway.

Livability

By centering on people – residents, business owners and visitors – North Bay Village will become a more attractive place to work, live and do business. The NBV100 Livability pillar puts the focus on placemaking in four ways:

- Prioritizing people over cars,
- · Embracing the waterfront,

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF NORTH BAY VILLAGE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) BEAUTIFICATION GRANT; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation's ("FDOT") Beautification Grant (the "Grant") provides financial assistance to local governments for use in projects to beautify their communities by landscaping roads; and

WHEREAS, North Bay Village (the "Village") takes pride in its landscape environment and promotes the aesthetics of its community and its infrastructure through beautification projects; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to undertake a beautification project for the median and right-of-way for the portion of SR 934/JFK Causeway/ NE 79 Street from the western-most median within the Village on SR 934 (at the western Village limit and eastern-end of the bridge; Mile Post 1,530) to the intersection of East Treasure Drive (Mile Post 2,399) (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, FDOT has advised that there are two future FDOT projects scheduled to take place within the same area as the Project (the "Bridge Projects"); notwithstanding, the Village does not anticipate that the Project will conflict with FDOT's Bridge Projects; and

WHEREAS, the Village will maintain the landscape in the medians related to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Manager recommends that the Village Commission approve the Grant application for the Project in substantially the form attached as Exhibit

"A" (the "Grant Application"), authorize the Village Manager to submit the Grant application, and authorize the Village Manager to execute any and all necessary agreements and documents associated with the Grant and maintenance of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission desires to approve the Grant Application, authorize the Village Manager to submit the Grant Application, and execute the necessary agreements and documents associated with the Grant and maintenance of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the Village.

WHEREAS, North Bay Village ("Village") issued Request for Qualifications No. 2019-005 (the "RFQ") for continuing professional engineering services (the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the RFQ, the Village Commission selected Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (the "Consultant") as one of the consultants to provide the Services and authorized the Village Manager to execute an agreement with Consultant (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Consultant has provided a proposal, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," (the "Proposal") to perform design, permitting, and bidding assistance services for the Kennedy Causeway Median Beautification project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission desires to authorize the Village Manager to issue a work order for the Project consistent with the Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and the Agreement previously entered into between the Village and Consultant; and
