WHEREAS, on September 29, 2021, the North Bay Village (the "Village") Commission adopted Resolution No. 2021-54 approving the budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 (the "Budget"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35.21 of the Village Code of Ordinances and Florida Law, the Village Commission desires to amend the Budget consistent with the staff memorandum accompanying this resolution by authorizing the line item transfers as further provided in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein to cover the accrual costs arising from the retirement of two Village police officers; and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF NORTH BAY VILLAGE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. That each of the above-stated recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

Section 2. <u>Amending Budget.</u> That the Village Commission hereby approves an amendment to the budget by authorizing the line item transfers as further provided in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

RECOMMENDATION

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF NORTH BAY VILLAGE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 TO COVER THE ACCRUAL COSTS ARISING FROM THE RETIREMENT OF TWO POLICE OFFICERS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff recommends the approval of the budget amendment appropriating \$134,345 from Unreserved Fund Balance to pay for the accruals of the Police Officers that retired last quarter.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

Police Officers Walter Sajdak and Reinaldo Marabotto announced their retirement this Fiscal Year. Since this announcement was made after the adoption of the current year's budget there were not any funds budgeted for the accruals, therefore a budget amendment is required to cover the compensated personnel.

Discussion of this item will help to make North Bay Village financially safer and more transparent; as such, it promotes the pillar of Efficiency.

Transfer \$134,350 from Appropriation of Unreserved Fund Balance (001.00.389.3891) to Compensation Personnel (001.21.521.1600) \$114.565, FICA (001.21.521.2100) \$8,764, and Retirement (001.21.521.2200) \$11,021.
