The candidate receiving a majority of the votes for the Commissioner At Large seat shall be elected into office for a four (4) year term.

BOND REFERENDUM

At the Village Commission Meeting held on July 19, 2022, the Village Commission adopted a Resolution calling for a Bond Referendum, to determine whether the qualified electors of the Village approve the issuance of the Bonds to finance the cost to the Village for the following project.

BALLOT QUESTION

Bond Referendum For Stormwater And Roadway Improvements To Mitigate Sea Level Rise And Flooding Impacts

Shall the Village issue general obligation bonds not to exceed \$60 million in one or more series maturing not later than thirty years from their issuance dates, bearing interest not exceeding the maximum allowable by law, payable from ad valorem taxes levied by the Village, to finance the costs of stormwater and related roadway improvements to mitigate the effects of sea level rise and flooding?
