Seawall Permit Package Requirements

- 1. Completed and notarized permit application with all original signatures.
 - If more than one trade is involved, all trade permit applications must be submitted together with the master permit.
 - If the contractor does not have worker's compensation insurance, a "Workers Comp Hold Harmless" form must be submitted with the permit application.
- 2. Proof of ownership (Property Appraiser Printout or Deed)
 - If the owner is an entity, please provide a copy of the articles of incorporation including the list of registered/authorized agents, and a copy of a valid ID of the agent that has signed the permit application.
- 3. Plans to comply with the following Seawall Code Requirements:
 - Minimum Cap Elevation
 - o 5.94 ft NAVD (7.50 ft NGVD) with ability to raise cap additional 2.5 ft in future
 - Coastal Engineering Considerations
 - Wave impact
 - o Storm surge
 - Hydrostatic loads due to tidal prism lag
 - o Toe scour
 - Overtopping
 - Seepage
 - Minimum Design Service Life
 - o 25 Years
 - Allowable Seawall Configurations
 - o Concrete Pile and Panel Walls
 - o University of Miami's Glass Fiber Polymer Reinforced Concrete Wall
 - Sheet Pile Wall
 - Steel
 - Composite
 - Living Shorelines
- 4. Copy of executed contract.
 - Must include the cost for all labor and materials (finishes and fixtures) for proposed work, including value of any owner provided materials.
 - Cost estimate or appraisal of complete seawall replacement.
- 5. Upfront processing fee to be collected at time of submittal, amount to be determined by the Building Clerk.
