Our Agency's performance during the past year demonstrated an unwavering commitment to our noble profession highlighted by outstanding accomplishments, superior community policing interactions, and the flawless delivery of exemplary public safety services. The Police Department's Mission, Vision, and Values have continued to raise the bar in all law enforcement related operational and administrative areas for a cohesive team of professionals constantly striving for excellence. The Organization's successful progression with our initiatives/goals and subsequent outcomes has continued to build on a quickly evolving reputation of being one of the more prolific law enforcement agencies in Miami-Dade County and the South Florida region. Through a successful combination of proactive enforcement activities, optimal community/law enforcement partnerships, and embracing all around industry best practices, we have produced winning internal and external atmosphere supported and celebrated across the board by everyone. The following list contains many of the notable accomplishments that has elevated our Agency in a variety of ways:

General Departmental Accomplishments

- Implemented a Succession Plan for all four Sergeants in anticipation of future projected organizational transition.
- Two Sergeants graduated from prestigious command and leadership schools (FDLE's Florida Leadership Academy and the FBI National Academy).
- Acquired a new first of its kind and state of the art Police Vessel
- Further reorganized the Agency to maximize efficient and effective performance.
- Hired additional sworn personnel (2-FT Sworn).
- Acquired seven new hybrid Police SUV Patrol Vehicles in pursuit of eco-friendly options.
- Department wide in-house Active Shooter/Counter Terrorism Training conducted TIES (Treasure Island Elementary School) during the summer break.
- Conducted MCAT (Mass Casualty Attack) Training at MDPD for our entire Agency.
- Continued Department wide Crisis Intervention Training.
- Hosted Multi-Agency LGBTQ Coalition meetings.
- Continued proactive high visibility STVR (Short Term Vacation Rentals) enforcement campaign producing significant and positive results.
- Obtained fire extinguishers for all Patrol personnel.
- Implemented numerous traffic enforcement initiatives and participated in multiple partner Agencies traffic enforcement campaigns.
- Recertified all personnel in CPR/AED.
- Selected as MDCACP Officer of the Month Awards winners (on two separate months).
- Transitioned to new PD uniforms with new Village branding completed and issued.

- Body Worn Camera Program launch, implementation is now fully operational.
- Conducted multiple hurricane plan/emergency plan deployments.
- Ongoing Parking Enforcement activities.
- Prepared and executed numerous holiday/special event operational plans (Spring Break, Memorial Day Weekend, Religious Events/Details, etc.).
- Obtained several additional assets through grants and donations including body armor, laptops, and other assets at no cost to the Village.
- Acquired a Community Policing/Therapy K-9 "Willy" and selected Master Sergeant Amy Gordon as the handler.
- Deputy Chief Bejar was sworn in as MDCACP (Miami-Dade County Association of Chiefs of Police) President.
- Continued the preparation of the Agency (facility, equipment, etc.) and administrative process (policies, records, etc.) to successfully complete the CFA (Commission of Florida Accreditation) for Law Enforcement accreditation process.
- Acquired and expanded PD office space to accommodate Professional Standards needs and relocation.
- Successfully settled FMIT insurance claim for catastrophic incident with prior Marine Patrol Vessel recovering money for the Village.
- Maximized auction results for surplus Police Department Assets.
- Marine Operator certification course completed by several personnel for our new wave runner.
