Termination Reports

Termination Reports are due within 90 days after having withdrawn, become unopposed, been eliminated, or elected to office, each candidate shall dispose of all funds in the campaign account and file a termination report. [F.S. 106.141(1)]

Failure to file a report on the designated due date shall subject the candidate to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day; not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report, as provided in F.S. Section 106.07(8). Fines must be paid from the candidate's personal funds – not campaign funds.

The Village Clerk will review reports for timeliness of filing, and typographical and mathematical accuracy. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure that the information contained in the reports is true and correct.

F.S. 106.08(3)(a) Any contribution received by a candidate with opposition in an election or by the campaign treasurer or a deputy campaign treasurer of such a candidate on the day of that election or less than 5 days before the day of that election must be returned by him or her to the person or committee contributing it and may not be used or expended by or on behalf of the candidate.

The deadline for accepting campaign contributions is <u>Thursday, October 31, 2024</u>, at midnight, which is five (5) days prior to the General Election.
