Summary of Proposed Ordinance and Statement of Public Purpose to be Served

The attached Ordinance authorizes North Bay Village to utilize speed detection systems to enforce certain school zone speeding violations pursuant to Chapter 203-174 of the Laws of Florida, and accordingly, is necessary to comply with State Law under Chapter 203-174 of the Laws of Florida. The Ordinance will protect members of the public, especially school children, parents, and teachers commuting to Treasure Island Elementary School, which is located within a school zone that has been determined to constitute a heightened safety risk that warrants additional traffic enforcement measures pursuant to Section 316.008(9), Florida Statutes.
