Summary of Proposed Ordinance and Statement of Public Purpose to be Served

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF NORTH BAY VILLAGE, FLORIDA, REPEALING SECTION 52.02, “GARBAGE FROM DOMESTIC OR INDUSTRIAL FOOD GRINDERS,” OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ELIMINATE THE PROHIBITION ON GARBAGE DISPOSAL INSTALLATIONS IN THE VILLAGE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The purpose of the proposed Ordinance is to repeal § 52.02 of the Village Code to eliminate the prohibition on garbage disposal installations in the Village.
