

ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY MEASURES TO BE IMPLEMENTED BY NORTH BAY VILLAGE EFFECTIVE IMMEDITELY

As Village Manager for North Bay Village, Florida, and pursuant to the authority vested in me under title V, Chapter 54 of the North Bay Village Code of Ordinances (the "Village Code"), as well as that certain North Bay Village Declaration of State of Emergency, dated March 12, 2020, I hereby put in place the following additional emergency measures, which are consistent with procedures being taken by Miami-Dade County and other surrounding municipalities. The following orders will be reasonably and necessarily implemented in response to this State of Emergency:

- This amendment shall serve as the first amendment to the order issued on March 16, 2020, regarding Village Parks, Events and Advisory Board and Commission meetings, modifying as follows:
 - Vogel Park will reopen on a limited bases on Monday, May 4, 2020 with the following park rules in addition to the standard park rules displayed on signage:
 - Park hours are from 7am 8pm Monday through Friday.
 - Seniors will have priority 7am 9am.
 - Individual and family passive limited activity only.
 - All park patrons must wear a face mask while visiting the park.
 - No groups of 10 or more will be allowed, and everyone must maintain a distance of 6 feet apart at all times.
 - Village staff may limit the number of persons using the park.
 - Selected walking will be one way to help ensure social distancing.
 - NO picnics allowed; picnic areas closed.
 - NO recreational programming, pickup games, organized activities or competitive games will be allowed.
 - · Restrooms will remain closed.
 - Fitness stations and playground area remains closed.
- All other Village Parks will remain CLOSED until further notice.
- All Village Events are POSTPONED until further notice.
- All Advisory Board and Commission meetings will resume a normal schedule via a virtual meeting in May.

The additional emergency measures that have been ordered and promulgated above shall be effective immediately.
