PUBLIC NOTICE OF ATTORNEY-CLIENT SESSION**

Notice is hereby given that the Village Commission of the North Bay Village, Florida will conduct a special public meeting and attorney-client session in accordance with Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes, on: Monday, October 23, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. at North Bay Village, Village Hall, 1666 Kennedy Causeway, Suite 300, North Bay Village, Florida 33141.

The subject matter of the meeting shall be confined to settlement negotiations or strategy sessions related to litigation expenditures in the pending litigation styled: **Catherine McKnight; Robert McKnight; Ernesto Gil; Laura Cattabriga; Lidia Steiner; Mary Kramer; and Lourdes Soto v. Brent W. Latham; Richard Chervony; Goran Cuk; Andy Daro; Rachel Streifeld; North Bay Village; and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida (Miami-Dade Case No.: 2023-023662-CA-01).**

The following persons will attend this attorney-client session: Mayor Brent Latham, Vice Mayor Dr. Richard Chervony, and Commissioners Goran Cuk, Andy Rotondaro, Rachel Streifeld; Village Manager Ralph Rosado; Village Attorneys Haydee Sera, Esq., Chad Friedman, Esq., Joseph H. Serota, Esq. and Blayne Yudis, Esq. of Weiss Serota Helfman Cole & Bierman, P.L.; and a Certified Court Reporter.

The Executive Session will last approximately thirty minutes. The session shall commence at an open meeting at which the chair shall announce the commencement and estimated length of the attorney-client session and the names of the persons attending. At the conclusion of the attorney-client session, the meeting shall be reopened, and the chair shall announce the termination of the session.

The entire session shall be recorded by a certified court reporter, who shall record the times of commencement and termination of the session, all discussion and proceedings, the names of all persons present at any time, and the names of all persons speaking. No portion of the session shall be off the record. The court reporter's notes shall be fully transcribed and filed with the Village Clerk within a reasonable time after the meeting. The transcript shall be made part of the public record upon conclusion of the litigation.

IF A PERSON DECIDES TO APPEAL ANY DECISION MADE BY THE BOARD, AGENCY, OR COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO ANY MATTER CONSIDERED AT THIS MEETING OR HEARING, HE OR SHE WILL NEED A RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS, AND FOR SUCH PURPOSE, HE OR SHE MAY NEED TO ENSURE THAT A VERBATIM RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS IS MADE, WHICH RECORD INCLUDES THE TESTIMONY AND EVIDENCE UPON WHICH THE APPEAL IS TO BE BASED.
