§ 32.18 - Membership limitation.

No individual shall serve on more than one Advisory Board at the same time unless a vacancy persists on any given Board after promotion of the vacancy for 90 days; thereafter, an individual already serving on an Advisory Board may be eligible to serve on a second Advisory Board. The foregoing notwithstanding, no individual may serve on more than two Advisory Boards simultaneously. All Advisory Board members shall serve without compensation and shall not otherwise obtain direct or indirect financial gain from their service in the Advisory Board (Ord. No. 2020-003, § 2, 1-14-20).

ADVISORY BOARDS/COMMITTEES

Community Enhancement Advisory Board

Recognizing the value of scenic surroundings to tourists, prospective residents, and commercial developments, as well as the citizens and taxpayers of the Village, and further preserving the quality of the environment, the purpose of the Community Enhancement Board is to consider and advance improvements, programs, and services meant to enhance the aesthetic appeal of the Village.

Resident Services Advisory Board

The purpose of the Resident Services Board is to assist the Village Mayor and Commission in developing programs, projects, and policies that enhance the quality of life for the Village's residents, including, but not limited to, the community's youth.

Financial Advisory Board

The purpose of the Financial Advisory Board is to consider and make recommendations on all issues affecting the fiscal policies and procedures of the units and departments within the Village and to assist the Village Manager, Commission, and Village Staff in the establishment of priorities in the Village's yearly budget and to maintain supervision of any bond dollars except items which could create potential legal liability, such as, but not limited to, cone of silence, active procurements, contract disputes and bid protests in which will be excluded.

Animal Welfare Advisory Board

The Animal Welfare Advisory Board aims to consider matters related to animal control within the Village limits and enhance the Village's ability to effectively handle animal issues.

Sustainability and Resiliency Task Force

The Sustainability and Resiliency Task Force aims to provide technical assistance and advice to the North Bay Village Commission on mitigation and adaptation measures to respond to global warming and climate change.

Planning and Zoning Advisory Board

The purpose of the Planning and Zoning Board is to recommend to the Village Commission all matters within the general purview of planning, zoning, and development.
