SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF NORTH BAY VILLAGE, FLORIDA, AWARDED INVITATION TO BID NO. 2025-007 TO ARANGO BILLBOARD AND CONSTRUCTION CO., LLC FOR THE VILLAGE'S KENNEDY CAUSEWAY COMPLETE STREETS SHORT TERM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$562,262.09; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE - VILLAGE MANAGER FRANK ROLLASON

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Village Commission authorize the Village Manager to negotiate and enter a Construction Agreement with Arango Billboard & Construction for the Kennedy Causeway Complete Streets Short Term Improvements Project for a contract amount of \$562,262.09.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The proposed Resolution seeks the Village Commission's approval to award a contract to Arango Billboard & Construction Co., LLC in response to Invitation to Bid [ITB] 2025-007 Kennedy Causeway Complete Streets Short Term Improvements Project.

SR 934/Kennedy/79th Street Causeway is NBV's principal urban corridor and sole connection to mainland Florida by connecting to the City of Miami to the west and the City of Miami Beach to the east. The roadway is a State Road facility under the jurisdiction of the FDOT. It is a wide, 6-lane facility with narrow sidewalks, and traffic flows at high speed, making it unappealing and unsafe for pedestrians and bicyclists. The Village has a master plan (NBV100) with one goal: to transform SR 934/Kennedy/79th Street Causeway into a complete street that better services the Village's core, prioritizing the safety of its residents, the coherence of its multi-modal network, and success of local businesses.
